Slaybaugh School has developed and will be participating in an important initiative program starting the first full week in October. It is called **The Slaybaugh School Bus Super Hero!!**

This program will create a safer and more effective bus ride to and from school for our students. The program focuses on improving our school's ability to teach and support positive behavior for all students when riding the bus. It is an approach to creating a safe

We have adopted a unified set of bus rules. These rules define our expectations for behavior in our school. You will see these rules posted throughout the school and on the bus. Your child will be learning them during his or her first weeks at school. Our unified bus rules, found in every bus and in the halls at school in the school are as follows:

- Go to seat
- Buckle Up
- Hands and feet to yourself
- Feet on the floor
- Use an inside voice.
- Use kind words
- Keep things in book bag
- Tell the bus driver if something happens



As part of our Slaybaugh School Bus Super Hero program, teachers, bus drivers and other staff members use positive praise and rewards to increase bus safety and decrease bus and classroom disruptions. To keep students on the rules in a positive manner the counselors, teachers, bus drivers and staff will remind the students often of the bus rules. Each week the bus drivers will nominate a student who has followed the rules and that student's name will be announced and that student will be awarded a Slaybaugh School Bus Super Hero Certificate.
