



Slaybaugh Parents' Club Committees

Here at The Slaybaugh Complex the Parents' Club helps with many activities throughout the school year. The Slaybaugh Parents' Club is run totally with the help of volunteers and donations. As a parent or guardian of a child in the Slaybaugh family you are automatically a member of the Parents' Club. All members are welcome to attend monthly meetings and asked to volunteer for various activities. Below are a few of the committees that are in need of volunteers. - **Book Fair**
During the school year there are two book fairs, one in the fall and one in the spring. The book fair runs for a week. Help is needed to set-up, help children choose books, help the librarian fill and restock books and break-down at the end of the week.
- **Food Drive**
The Food Drive is held during the month of November. Donated non-perishable items are collected during the month, then sorted and distributed to Slaybaugh families that are in need.
- **Fun Day**
Fun Day is an activity day that is usually held at the end of the school year for all grades. Children have fun doing various activities, station style that are coordinated by the gym teacher. Organizing, set-up, running stations, passing out snacks and break down.

- Fundraising
Fundraising is very important to insure proper funding is available for the activities that Parents' Club helps to provide for the children of Slaybaugh. Help is needed organizing, collecting, and distributing materials for fundraisers.
- Holiday Event
Every year during winter a holiday event is hosted by the Parents' Club. Help is needed organizing, setting up, running and breaking down this event.
- Label for Education/Box Tops collection
These two programs are third party programs that are offered to help schools raise money and/or collect points to be used for purchasing various supplies and equipment. Help is needed collecting, counting, sorting and mailing to the companies that are a part of these programs.
- Read Across America
This is a national program that is used in many schools during the week of Dr. Seuss's birthday in March. During Read Across America week; Ready, Set, Read night is held at Slaybaugh. This event is centered on making reading fun for children. Help is needed to plan, organize, set-up and break down for this night.
- Bakers
Often during planned events there is a need for bake sales. Bakers will be asked prior to events to prepare pre-packaged items to be sold at these events.
- Teacher & Staff Appreciation
In the spring we celebrate our teachers and staff by showing our appreciation for them. Help is needed organizing special treats for the teachers and staff. Often a luncheon or brunch is held.
