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Student Attendance Expectations for the Hybrid Model

Student Attendance - [EHT Policy 5200](#)

1. Students are expected to follow the daily schedule whether they are in-school or receiving virtual instruction for the day.
2. Students who are 100% virtual learners or who are hybrid students participating in their virtual learning day should follow their daily school schedule and complete all assignments, including viewing videos, completing practice activities, or other work as assigned by the classroom teacher.
3. All students should follow their schedule and be prepared to attend their **synchronous - "live"** classes when they are scheduled for virtual. Cameras and Mics should be active and functioning during the class (mute your mic unless the teacher requests you to unmute to avoid feedback). Small group instruction/virtual help time is required for all students who are virtual or are scheduled by their teacher to attend. Students who do not report for a live class will be considered absent from the class. If three or more live classes are missed the student will be considered absent for the day.
4. Parents of any students who are not able to follow the live instruction schedule should contact their building administration to discuss their extenuating circumstance.

All Virtual Instruction Day (Monday)

1. Attend live virtual instruction each period following your daily schedule
2. Set up your virtual learning space
 - a. Find a quiet space to attend your asynchronous-"live" class
 - b. Mic on (mute when not talking to avoid feedback)
 - c. Camera on (use a virtual background if available)





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- d. Be fully dressed and in a quiet, public space in your home (laying on your bed or couch is not acceptable during live instruction)
 - e. Be prepared to engage in the lesson
 - f. When the camera is on avoid distracting movements or actions in the camera (Avoid bringing your pet or other objects into the camera view)
 - g. Check that that you have adequate lighting and that you are visible on the camera
 - h. Consider putting a live sign on your door so that family members know that you are actively engaged in a class
3. Attendance will be taken each period or by the homeroom and special area teacher

In-Person Hybrid Student

1. Complete daily health screen including temperature check.
2. Arrive at school on time.
3. Follow the daily schedule and attend in-person classes.
4. Masks, covering both the mouth and nose, are required and must be worn at all times while in the building.
5. Attendance will be taken in each class.

Hybrid Virtual Student

1. Login to the Infinite Campus portal to confirm your attendance at the start of each day
2. Set up a virtual learning space that will allow you to successfully work independently on school assignments
3. Follow daily schedule and attend live virtual classes
4. Attendance will be taken in each class
5. Be prepared to engage in the lesson. Do not log on and off. Your mic and camera are expected to be on as you are a full participant in the class.
6. Pay attention to class and do not be involved in non-school related activity or conversation.





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7. When the camera is on avoid distracting movements or actions in the camera.
8. Students must attend small group and virtual help sessions as scheduled each day.

100% Virtual Student

1. Login to the Infinite Campus portal to confirm your attendance at the start of each day

How to Handle Technical Difficulties

If you are attending class via Google Meet and you or your teacher gets disconnected from that Meet, please follow the guidelines below and any additional procedures outlined by your teacher.

If you experience technical difficulty:

1. Wait a few minutes and try to reconnect to the class.
2. If this is not possible, send a message to your teacher, identifying when you were disconnected from the class.
3. Your teacher will indicate when during the afternoon small group instruction time to connect with you, if needed.

If your teacher experiences technical difficulty:

1. Wait a few minutes for your teacher to reconnect.
2. Check the Google Classroom stream for directions and information posted by your teacher



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3. Follow procedures previously outlined by your teacher regarding technical difficulties.

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
